PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain is formulated with a heavier body. Its non-drip formula is ideal for vertical surfaces.

APPLICATION TECHNIQUES

Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain can be applied with a rag or natural bristle brush. For wood or textured surfaces, the stain is wiped or brushed on and gently rubbed into the grain. The excess should be wiped off with a rag. For metal or other substrates, a graining tool can be used. To increase color intensity, allow the stain to dry for 5 hours, then apply a second coat.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dry time: Allow 24 hours before general use and 24 hours minimum for non-wood surfaces

Topcoat/Recoat application: After 5 hours

Clean-up: Mineral spirits or paint thinner

Coverage: 200-400 sq. ft. per quart

For use on: All soft and hard, new and stripped wood

Ideal for: Use on doors, furniture, and trim, and interior cabinets, paneling, and floors

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where should Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain be used? Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain can be used on all types of wood, composite, fiberglass doors, and metal surfaces.

How should Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain be applied? Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain goes on easy with a clean, lint-free cloth. Any excess can be simply wiped off in the direction of the grain. (See "Application Techniques" above for further details.)

Can this product be used to "grain" non-wood surfaces? Yes. For graining metal or fiberglass doors, special applicators (graining tools) are available.

How does Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain compare to Olympic Premium Wood Stain? Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain imparts rich, beautiful color to a variety of surfaces. Because of its thicker body, it is not prone to run or drip.

Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain colors softwoods evenly without the use of a wood conditioner.

A topcoat is required with Olympic Premium Oil Based Gel Stain for exterior applications and recommended for interior applications. A topcoat is optional with Olympic Premium Interior Wood Stain.

Is a topcoat/clearcoat necessary? For interior applications, a topcoat of Olympic Premium Oil or Water Based Polyurethane or Olympic Premium Interior Fast Dry Varnish should be applied to enhance and protect the wood surface for long-lasting beauty. For exterior applications, use Olympic Interior/Exterior Spar Finish.
