PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane imparts a warm golden tone that enhances wood's natural beauty. The unique Smooth Flow™ Formula makes it easier to achieve a beautiful, exceptionally durable finish.

APPLICATION TECHNIQUES

Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane should be applied with a quality natural bristle brush or foam applicator. Its unique Smooth Flow™ Formula helps make smooth, even application easier than ever. However, a few simple tips will help ensure a professional finish:

- Never shake the can. Stir slowly to avoid creating air bubbles.
- Slowly work the finish into the wood with light, even strokes.
- The last stroke should be at a 45° angle with the brush and run the entire length of the work surface. This technique will remove any bubbles that may be trapped in the finish.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dry time: Allow 24 hours before general use and 72 hours for flooring

Recoat: After 8 hours

Clean-up: Mineral spirits or paint thinner

Coverage: 150 sq. ft. per quart

For use on: Stained, sealed, or bare wood

Ideal for: Doors, furniture, floors, tabletops, counter tops, and other high-use surfaces

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I select a sheen? Sheen selection is largely a matter of personal preference. Here are some guidelines:

- When maximum shine is desired, gloss is the ideal choice.
- For a finish with the lowest reflectivity, satin is the proper choice. Satin is especially well-suited for antique interiors. It's also widely used on hardwood floors, since it tends to hide dirt and scuff marks.

Is sanding required? To obtain the smoothest finish, a light sanding with #200 or finer sandpaper is recommended between coats. This process will remove any dust or finish imperfections and prepare the surface for an additional coat.

How many coats will be needed? It depends on the wood type, its absorbency, and how much abuse the surface will take. Three coats are generally used to obtain a professional finish. Once a coat has dried, examine the surface under bright, direct light. If dry spots are visible, an additional coat is necessary for maximum wood protection and beauty.

Floors take extra punishment. What's the best way to make sure Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane will stand up to the abuse? To stand up to wear and tear, three or more coats of Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane are often needed. This is especially true if Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane is applied to new or freshly sanded wood flooring, which will quickly soak up the first coat of finish.

Is waxing required? No. Our Oil Based Polyurethane is one of the most durable products available and will provide a beautiful finish for years to come. A light regular application of furniture cleaner is all that's needed for long-lasting beauty.

What factors influence the drying time? The drying time is affected by humidity, air temperature and film thickness. When the humidity is high and/or the temperature is low, Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane will take longer to dry. On the other hand, when the humidity is low and/or the temperature is high, Olympic Premium Oil Based Polyurethane will dry in less time.
